Glass votive cups make great gifts! Votive cups are suitable to be used for jelly/butter dishes or hold candies and nuts. Another use is to burn a small votive candle inside to add a glow to your evenings. Create an adorable votive cup by arranging cut pieces of glass on a 6"

clear glass base. Basic glass-cutting skills are taught so experience is not required. Just bring your enthusiasm and creativity! All supplies, tools, and instructions are included in the workshop fee. Please wear close-toed shoes when working with glass. A mask is required while in the Gallery. Protective eyewear is available if you do not wear glasses or bring your own.
