Learn to Draw*

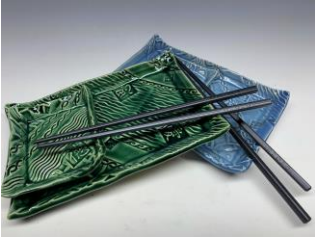
Artist: Sharon

Ceramic Sushi Set

Do you love getting your hands dirty? Here's your chance to do so with Daria who will lead you in this hand-built ceramic workshop! She will lead through the process of constructing your own set of sushi dishes. You will use a variety of stamps to texture your design into a slab of clay, and create functional trays for sushi. Your pieces will be fired to bisque and then glazed before firing again. Workshop fee includes clay, glaze, and 2 kiln-firings.

Fused Glass: Small Plate or Bowl!

This fused glass workshop features small bowls and plates. Participants will select a ceramic mold to determine the size of the base glass, then select from a variety of fusible glass pieces to design a top layer. After fusing the two layers together, the project will be slumped in the chosen ceramic mold to achieve the shapes of either a small bowl or plate. This workshop involves a variety of glass-cutting techniques which will be demonstrated, so experience is not necessary. Just bring your enthusiasm and creativity! Please do not wear open-toed shoes when working with glass. Workshop fee includes instruction, use of tools, glass, and 2 kiln-firings.

"A Walk in the Woods"

This workshop will be a chance to learn how to use flexible modelling paste. We will paint using sponges, brushes, and other tools. This technique can be used to recycle an old painting if it is acrylic!

Relief Carved Green Man

In this workshop, you will learn the basic woodcarving cutting strokes using a carving's bench knife and various chisels to relief carve a Green Man from a roughout in basswood bark. Bring your own tools or purchase tools that day at ArtForms Gallery.

etc. Great piece for people with metal sensitivities!
