Create a little glow of spring you can enjoy all year long. In this workshop, we will craft delicate wax paper lanterns using real pressed flowers, gentle heat, and simple layering techniques. Each lantern becomes soft, luminous artwork - perfect for tabletops, nightstands, or gifting to someone who needs a bit of light. Come unwind, play with color and texture, and make something that glows from the inside out. Sarah will demonstrate. All materials provided.

Flower Power! Fused Glass

Are your spring flowers not blooming yet! Attend this workshop and make a fused glass flower that won't wilt or fade! No glass cutting is required, but you will work with glass powder so a **face mask is required**. Using glass powders and water, participants will create a slurry in a variety of colors and design a glass flower to be fused on a ceramic mold. After drilling a hole, a copper tube will be inserted to make a free-standing flower for your home or flower bed.



Easy and fun—you don't need a "green thumb" to "grow" these flowers! Oh, and you don't have to worry about watering your new flower!
