Artist: Brenda Hayes

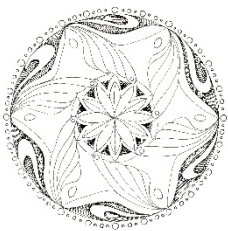
We will hand-stitch various fibers into one-of-a-kind fabric earrings. Adding beads and baubles. All materials will be provided.

Create 3 pocket vases to keep or give as gifts! You will create a design by arranging cut pieces of glass and adorable embellishments on a white glass base. Special ceramic paper will be sandwiched between your glass design layer and a clear base ready to fire in the kiln. The result is a pocket vase that actually holds water! Basic glass-cutting skills are taught so experience is not required. Just bring your enthusiasm and creativity! All supplies, tools, instructions, and kiln-firing are included in the workshop fee. Please wear close-toed shoes when working with glass. Protective eyewear is available if you do not wear glasses or you may bring your own.

Young Artist Camp! Round II
