This painting workshop focuses on the impasto technique. ("Impasto is a technique used in painting, where paint is laid on an area of the surface in very thick layers, usually thick enough that the brush or painting-knife strokes are visible. Paint can also be mixed right on the canvas. When dry, impasto provides texture; the paint appears to be coming out of the canvas." Wikipedia)



You will achieve texture and special effects by using flexible molding paste, gloss gel, laser iridescent paste, gilding flakes, and mother of pearl. All materials are provided. We will have fun and take our time on this. It is appropriate for beginners or people interested in improving skills in this area.
