Bookmaking: The Quickest Bookmaking Method Ever! Artist: Rebecca Lomshek

Learn to make your own pamphlet style, hand sewn sketchbook! You will make not just one, but three sketchbooks. Small, but mighty at 20 pages per book and 8" X 5.5". This bookmaking method is quick and versatile, leaving time to spare for other projects. All materials will be supplied for you, just show up, create and leave with handmade books and a few bookmaking tools to call your own!

Metalsmithing with Rivets!

Artist: Nicole Meyer-Foresman

Use mixed metals and the cold connection process of riveting to create one of a kind artwork. Participants need no experience to design and fabricate copper, brass and silver. Choose between a pair of earrings, pendant or both if you are a fast worker! Each attendee will be given a 1" x 1" piece of sterling silver to incorporate into your work. Techniques learned include sawing, filing, how to use a rolling mill, oxidize and rivet.

All supplies are provided.

Flower Power! Fused Glass Artist: Dianne

Are your spring flowers not blooming yet! Attend this workshop and make a fused glass flower that won't wilt or fade! No glass cutting is required, but you will work with glass powder so a face mask is required. Using glass powders and water, participants will create a slurry in a variety of colors and design a glass flower to be fused on a ceramic mold. After drilling a hole, a copper tube will be inserted to make a free-standing flower for your home or flower bed.



Easy and fun—you don't need a "green thumb" to "grow" these flowers! Oh, and you don't have to worry about watering your flower!
